


Ordeal Packing Instructions


Below you will find everything that is needed for the night of your ordeal and how you can prepare this gear. All other gear should be packed separately and is to be stored until the following evening.

Gear Needed

- Sleeping bag
- Poncho or rain gear (the weekend goes on, rain or shine!)
- Ground cloth
- Plastic or metal cup
- Filled water bottle or small canteen (at least one quart)



Pack everything listed above inside your sleeping bag and then roll your sleeping bag with your ground cloth around it lengthwise and secure it with string as shown below.

Please Note: You will sleep out under the stars with only the equipment you bring, so be prepared. However, in inclement weather, you will sleep under cover.

NOTE: For Saturday night the scouts are allowed to camp in a tent that they bring with them. The scouts will pitch the tent Friday night before registration. The scouts should also bring with them to the Ordeal a full Class A uniform that they will wear Saturday night and Sunday. Friday night through Saturday afternoon the scouts should be dressed in clothes that they can work in and that can get dirty.
